GRADING TIERS	REQUIREMENTS (Maximum Value Per Note)
Unlimited WalkThrough	Unlimited value.
High Value WalkThrough	Notes valued up to ₹ 3,500,000.
WalkThrough	Notes valued up to ₹ 17,50,000.
Express	Notes valued up to ₹ 7,00,000.
Standard	Notes valued up to ₹ 2,00,000.
Economy	Notes valued up to ₹ 70,000 <b>except</b> errors, US BEP issued bonds, specimens, proofs, essays and / or notes not listed in <i>Paper Money of the United States</i> by Arthur and Ira Friedberg, <i>Standard Catalogue of United States Obsolete Bank Notes 1782–1866</i> by James Haxby, <i>Confederate and Southern States Currency</i> by Grover Criswell, <i>Military Payment Certificates</i> by Fred Schwan, <i>Charlton Standard Catalogue of Canadian Bank Notes</i> edited by R. J. Graham and <i>Standard Catalogue of World Paper Money</i> edited by Tracy Schmidt.
Economy Special	Notes valued up to ₹ 70,000. All errors, US BEP issued bonds, specimens, proofs, US essays and / or notes not listed in Friedberg, Haxby, Criswell, Schwan, Charlton, or the <i>Standard Catalogue of World Paper Money</i> .
Modern (1960–Present)	Notes valued up to ₹ 20,000. All notes issued 1960 to present <b>except</b> error notes, US BEP-issued bonds, specimens, proofs, US essays and / or notes not listed in Friedberg, Schwan, Charlton or the <i>Standard Catalogue of World Paper Money</i> .
<b>Bulk Submission</b>	<b>Applies to all bulk submissions:</b> Notes valued up to ₹ 20,000. <b>Fifty (50)-note minimum.</b> The following notes are <b>NOT</b> eligible for bulk submission tiers: error notes, US BEP-issued bonds, specimens, proofs, US essays, Chinese notes issued from 1948 through the 1953 First Series notes (Pick numbers 800 to 859) and / or notes not listed in Friedberg, Schwan, Charlton or the <i>Standard Catalogue of World Paper Money</i> .
Consecutive Notes	All notes must be the same catalogue number and all serial numbers must be in consecutive order. All vintage or modern notes are accepted provided they meet the bulk requirements above.
• Mixed Vintage (Pre-1960)	Notes may be a mix of catalogue numbers and / or serial numbers. All notes issued before 1960 are accepted, provided they meet the bulk requirements above.
• Mixed Modern (1960–Present)	Notes may be a mix of catalogue numbers and / or serial numbers. All notes issued 1960 to present are accepted, provided they meet the bulk requirements above.
ADD-ON SERVICES	DESCRIPTION
Early Releases / First Releases	Use this service to receive either the Early Releases or First Releases designation.
Special Label	Use this service to request a special PMG label. For a list of special PMG labels, visit <a href="http://PMGnotes.in/labels">PMGnotes.in/labels</a> . Note: Use different forms for different special labels.
PMG Oversize Holder	Notes sized 195 x 120 mm to 205 x 220 mm must be submitted on a separate form.
Custom Holder	Available for multi-note sets, uncut sheets and notes larger than 205 x 220 mm must be submitted on a separate form. Select Small Custom Holder for sizes up to 305 x 350 mm. Select Large Custom Holder for sizes 305 x 350 mm to 400 x 470 mm.
ReGrade	If you feel that a PMG-certified note is undergraded, you may submit the note for review for a higher grade. The note must be intact in its PMG holder. Also choose a grading tier according to note value. Regular grading fees apply.
Variety	Additional attribution not mentioned in Friedberg, Haxby, Criswell, Schwan, Charlton or the <i>Standard Catalogue of World Paper Money</i> , as well as all "f" fluorescence attributions for Chinese RMB notes.
Pedigree	Reserved for information pertaining to private or public collection (e.g., Ford Collection).
REHOLDERS	DESCRIPTION
ReHolder	A note in a PMG holder can be submitted for placement in a new holder. Notes valued up to ₹ 700,000.
High Value ReHolder	A note in a PMG holder can be submitted for placement in a new holder. Notes valued over ₹ 700,000.
OTHER SERVICES	DESCRIPTION
Appearance Review	Review of a PMG note you believe is overgraded.
Return Packaging	Examples include Certificates of Authenticity and folders / boxes. Does not include shipping expenses, if required.
